B.S. Health Care Leadership Program (HCL) Online

Rationale

The B.S. Health Care Leadership Program has been approved to be offered in an online format in order to offer prospective students an alternative to the face-to-face model. Some modules of the courses may also be offered as part of a blended delivery format.

Program Authorizations: The B.S. Health Care Leadership Program is authorized to be offered (face-to-face) in the following Illinois Regions: Chicago; North Suburban; West Suburban; South Metropolitan; and Fox Valley. The B.S. HCL is also authorized to be offered at NLU campuses in Florida, Virginia and Wisconsin. Students may now be enrolled in the online delivery format of the B.S. HCL Program.

IMPLEMENTATION DATE: First cohort of B.S. HCL students online Winter 2008; marketing and recruitment can begin immediately.
